



STAND Program Cost

Student Leadership Services, Inc. (SLS) developed a program called STAND (Students Taking A New Direction) in 1990. STAND is a grass-roots middle school based asset building prevention program. STAND is committed to the idea that empowerment of youth is a key element in the creation of drug free communities. STAND is designed for middle school students ages 11-14 in grades 6-8.

The STAND program consists of five components all of which help build youth development and life skills in 11-14 year old youth. The components are: Skill Development, Community Service, Parent Involvement, Social Activities (Chemical Free) and Safety Awareness.

STAND was evaluated by High/Scope Educational Research Foundation using the Youth Program Quality Assessment (YPQA) tool in 2005 and in 2008. The STAND Program is proven to build and provide Supportive Relationships, Safety, Youth Engagement, Youth Interaction, Asset Building, Life Skills and Drug Education Prevention.
